The workshop in Lublin is a capacity building initiative under the European ManagEnergy initiative operated by EC Network, organized as an element of the Smart Living Project initiated by the Danish Embassy in Warsaw. The workshop takes place in close cooperation with the regional authority (City of Lublin). It aims to target people from different areas including local decision makers, academia, energy groups and technological centers/clusters related to increasing energy efficiency in buildings as well as to smart energy management in the city.

The idea of the SMART LIVING Project is to create the cooperation based on an open dialogue between the academia, politics and business. The urban areas are growing more and more important due to the raising population and they are the essential determinants of the life quality and of the environmental condition. That is why we invite the cities authorities who aim to introduce the smart solutions in the cities which can contribute to the efficient management of the resources and to the improvement of the climate and to the living conditions.

One of the main goals of the workshop is to present the local stakeholders from the region with the successful examples of local energy plans that turned into real projects as well as to promote real sustainable energy measures/investments with the new period of EU funds as a main driver. During the workshop we shall also focus on how to build up advisory systems to support the sustainable energy planning process around Poland, using Lublin and the region as an example.
